Space. Stage that can hold all equipment and band members with the entire area visible to all members of the audience. Production shall have exclusive use of the Space from load-in through load-out. Stage and all ancillary spaces to be swept and mopped prior to every Company attended event.

Sound. Presenter will provide professional sound system as described in the attached rider. Please discuss your venue and equipment possibilities with Company. Presenter provides Monitor Audio Engineer, if necessary.

- Head set communication system with a minimum of 3 stations (lighting console, audio console, Stage Manager)
- Paging system from the Stage Manager location to the dressing room(s) and green room(s)

Lighting. Standard contemporary concert light plot with the ability to focus attention on each musician and create varied looks for a 70-90-minute performance. Basic Company suggested equipment described in rider. Light plot must be hung, plugged, soft-patched, and in full working order prior to company's arrival. All color and templates must be installed prior to company's arrival. **Presenter provides all color media and templates**.

Company travels with a glass gobo (Center Stage logo) and holder for a standard size ETC Source Four lighting instrument. Company can also provide digital media files for projection if available at venue. Please discuss options with Company Manager during advance.

Crew & Hours. This is not a union company. If the theater is a union house, please discuss crew needs with us in advance. Exact crew composition to be determined in consultation with Company. Crew members must be the same individuals for all rehearsals and performances. All crew members who work the performance, although employees of the Presenter, do so under the direction of the Company's technical staff.

Residency and Media Activities

For off-stage workshops, music-focused master classes, lec-dems, and radio or other broadcast activities, presenter will provide backline, sound equipment and other scenery/props as requested by the company.

Generally, for radio station interviews without full music sets, the Company will need a set of congas or a djembe. For classroom visits the Company will need sets of drums such as congas, djembes, "bombos", kick drums, floor toms, shakers, and drumsticks. Quantity of instruments is based on number of attendees.

Backstage Accommodations

Internet Access. High speed wifi access required.

Dressing Rooms/Wardrobe. Exclusive use of two chorus dressing rooms, each lockable and secure, to accommodate the Company conveniently located to the stage equipped with sufficient tables, chairs, mirrors, costume racks, and power outlets required. Rest rooms (not to be shared with the public) with showers (hot and cold water) and towels (minimum 7) required.

Green room. A large room (no public access) with tables and chairs sufficient to accommodate the full company is required. A sofa/couch is also appreciated.

Hospitality. Company travels with refillable water bottles. Please provide a freshwater bottle filling station or a source of potable water.

Hospitality for 9 persons for all full Company calls: Large fruit baskets (fresh and dried fruits), tray of meats and cheeses, cookies, crackers, and other light snacks (salty and sweet), coffee & tea service, soft drinks, Gatorade, orange and other fruit juices, honey, fresh ginger, lemons, and ice. Access to a refrigerator is appreciated.

Hot meal after performance required. Provide soup; main dish with chicken, meat, or fresh fish; vegetable salad; rice; garnish; and fresh juice. Vegetarian options required. The Company always prefers local food. Please discuss all hospitality plans with Company Manager during advance.

Parking Permits & Access. Presenter agrees to obtain all permits and authorization necessary to allow access for Company vehicle to the loading dock/stage door for the duration of the Company's engagement in the venue and to provide permits and authorization for parking Company vehicles within easy access other venues, as necessary, for the entire time the Company is in residence.

Performance Recording. Company may request audio and/or video recording, including multi-track, if possible, of the performance for non-commercial promotional and archival use.

Merchandise. One 6' table required for merchandise sales. Please discuss any sales requirements or Presenter withholding with Company Manager during advance.



2. SOUND (FOH AND MONITORS)

Professional sound system of recognized brand and reference that must guarantee 110 dB SPL at the back of the venue. The system must be wired for 3-way stereo operation and processed electronically by the system's own processor preferably.

The sound system FOH and Monitors must be properly tested, processed, aligned in phase and working correctly before starting the sound check.

Requirements:

- 1 Digital Console for FOH and Monitors
- 2 Side fills 3 ways depending on the size of the venue and whether it is outdoors or not.
- 7 identical floor monitors (same brand and reference)
- 2 Wireless Microphones Shure SM58 with transmitters UR2 + 1 Receiver UR4D
- Microphones, D.I. and bases: according to the input list (see Input List, Stage Plot)

3. ASSEMBLY AND SOUND CHECK

During the sound check there will only be on stage musicians, band staff and production technicians. During this time the doors for public access will be closed.

4. RISER

It requires a platform of 2.40m x 2.40m at a height of 0.60m (8' x 8' x 2'H). Completely secured and stable, with black fabric flaps on all sides, in perfect condition for the drums. (See Stage Plot.)

5. LIGHTING

Depending on the type of show, the following equipment is suggested:

- 24 Par 64 / Opti-pair 575W or higher Wash and Profile
- 06 Moving Heads
- 02 Atomik 3000
- 01 Digital lights console
- 01 Martin PRO Smoke Machine
